Spanish Explorer

Barcelona, Madrid, Seville & Granada

with excursions to Toledo, El Escorial, Segovia, Cordoba & Ronda

Day I: Fly out from USA

Begin your Spanish adventure today, starting with an overnight flight from the USA.

Day 2: Bienvenidos a España

Upon arrival in Spain you'll be met by your Global Explorers Tour Leader, who will accompany you throughout your tour. After checking into our centrally-located hotel for two-nights, this evening's first group dinner will be taken close to the city's famous *Las Ramblas*. Afterward we'll take an evening stroll to experience the atmosphere, a great way to end your first day in Spain.

Day 3: "Barcelona!"

Today is dedicated to discovering the vibrant & exciting city of Barcelona.

During the morning our expert local guide will introduce you to the capital of Catalonia, a distinct & proud region with its own history & traditions. Amongst the sights we'll visit will be the Sagrada Familia, a stunning still-incomplete cathedral, that is just one of the architectural masterpieces in Barcelona designed by Antoni Gaudi.

During the afternoon you will have free time to explore at leisure - perhaps to visit the Picasso Museum, to tour the home of F.C.Barcelona, or just to lie on the beach!

Day 4: From Catalunya to Castilla

Leaving Barcelona & the coast behind this morning, we journey south-west towards the Spanish capital Madrid, located in the heart of the Iberian peninsula.

En-route we'll visit the city of Zaragoza, a major city that is home to northern Spain's greatest Moorish palace & two cathedrals.

Later we will arrive in Madrid for three nights & enjoy our group dinner in the heart of this fun capital.

Day 5: Madrid in depth

Discover the Spanish capital this morning, as our local guide leads us on a tour of Madrid. Afterwards we'll visit the renowned Prado Museum, home to Spain's greatest art, including works by El Greco, Velaquez & Goya...

Later in the day enjoy a taste of Madrilenos' relaxed pace of life on our leisurely walking tour of the city's squares, including trying some of the city's best hot chocolate & churros!



Day 6: The Capital Region - Toledo

Today we venture outside Madrid, to explore Toledo.

Just an hour south of the capital, Toledo is one of Spain's highlights, a wonderfully atmospheric medieval city that was home to the artist El Greco. Indeed many of his works are still located here. The city also once enjoyed a reputation as Europe's leading center for sword-making. On our guided tour we will find evidence of all this & more.

We return to Madrid this afternoon in time for our group dinner.

Day 7: La Mancha - the road to the South

We depart Madrid this morning & travel south to the Andalucia region, traveling through the La Mancha region - made famous in Cervantes' Don Quixote..

En-route we stop in Cordoba to visit the Mezquita, the former mosque of a city that was the cultural & intellectual capital of Europe 1,000 years ago!

In the afternoon we continue towards Seville, a city of orange blossoms & flamenco music, where we'll check-in for a two-night stay before enjoying an introductory stroll to dinner.

Day 8: Seville, City of Flamenco & Oranges

Today we discover the treasures & delights of Seville with a half-day guided walking tour. A visit to the Cathedral (burial place of Christopher Columbus) & its famous *Giralda* tower, is included, as well as exploring the narrow streets & alleys of the *Barrio Santa Cruz*, Seville's once thriving Jewish Quarter.

The afternoon today is totally free for you to enjoy Seville at your own pace before we rendezvous for dinner & an evening flamenco performance.

Day 9: Ronda & the mountains of Andalucia

We board our bus this morning for the journey to Granada, taking us through the Serrania de Ronda mountains. The highlight of our day will be an extended visit to Ronda, the most famous of the region's 'white cities', an incredible town perched precariously above a deep gorge, its houses clinging to the cliffs.

Later we continue to Granada where, after checking-in for a two-night stay, we'll get familiar with the city on an introductory walking tour before dinner in an authentic local restaurant.

Day 10: Granada & the Alhambra

Today is devoted to Granada & the Alhambra Palace, a reminder of the centuries of Moorish rule in southern Spain & perhaps the most exotic building in Europe. Our guided sightseeing tour will explore the fantastic palace, & introduce you to the history of Muslim Spain, then later your tour leader will lead you on a short orientation walk through the city center, ending with gelato at one of the city's many *gelateria*. Granada's narrow streets & hidden squares are a delight to explore & there will be ample free time to wander this colorful city, or simply to relax.

Day II: Adiós Espana!

Sadly it's time to depart this morning for your flight from Malaga to the USA, arriving home later the same day.
